Rules for U.G. Hostel - BOYS

1. General Conduct

- 1.1. All students must respect hostel authorities, staff, and fellow students.
- 1.2. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. Anyone found guilty of ragging or abetting ragging is liable to be punished in accordance with anti-ragging regulations as well as under the provisions of any penal law for the time being in force and immediate expulsion and banned from the hostel.
- 1.3. Any form of discrimination based on caste, gender, religion, or ethnicity is strictly forbidden.
- 1.4. Smoking, consumption of alcohol, or possession of prohibited substances/items/equipment is strictly banned within hostel premises.
- 1.5. Carrying a valid college ID card is mandatory and must be presented when asked by the hostel authorities.

2. Attendance and Timings

- 2.1. Students must be inside the hostel premises by 11:00 PM. Late entries without prior permission will not be allowed.
- 2.2. Leaving the hostel premises between 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM (odd hours) without prior permission is prohibited, and students will bear full responsibility for their actions.
- 2.3. Absence from the hostel overnight requires written approval from the warden and a formal application from the parent/guardian.
- 2.4. Interns on emergency duty must carry and show their ID card while entering or leaving the hostel during odd hours.

3. Visitors

- 3.1. Visitors are allowed only during designated hours (9:00 AM to 7:00 PM).
- 3.2. Visitors must sign the visitor's register at the entrance and provide valid ID proof.
- 3.3. Female visitors are not allowed in hostel rooms; meetings should take place in common areas only.

4. Cleanliness and Maintenance

- 4.1. Students must keep their rooms and common areas clean and tidy.
- 4.2. Footwear must be kept in designated areas or neatly outside rooms. Improper placement will not be tolerated.
- 4.3. Garbage must be disposed of in designated bins, and littering in bathrooms, corridors, and hostel premises is strictly prohibited.
- 4.4. Damaging hostel property will result in fines and disciplinary action.

5. Room Allotment and Occupancy

- 5.1. Rooms are allotted at the discretion of hostel authorities.
- 5.2. Students cannot change or exchange rooms without prior written permission from the warden.
- 5.3. Unauthorized room occupancy will result in fines and expulsion from the hostel.

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6. Facilities Usage

- 6.1. Shared facilities must be used responsibly and without causing inconvenience to others.
- 6.2. Misuse or damage to common amenities will result in penalties.
- 6.3. Electrical appliances are strictly prohibited within the hostel. If found, they will be confiscated, and the students will face disciplinary action, including potential expulsion.

7. Safety and Security

- 7.1. Students must securely lock their rooms and are solely responsible for their belongings.
- 7.2. Fire safety measures must be strictly followed, and tampering with fire extinguishers or safety equipment is prohibited.
- 7.3. Unauthorized entry of outsiders/delivery agents is strictly forbidden.

8. Discipline and conduct

- 8.1. Physical fights, verbal abuse, or any form of violence will result in strict disciplinary action.
- 8.2. Loud music or disturbances, especially during study hours and at night (9:00 PM to 7:00 AM), are prohibited.
- 8.3. False information provided to hostel authorities will lead to severe penalties, including expulsion.

9. Room Transfers and Shifting

- 9.1. Shifting from one room to another without authorization is prohibited.
- 9.2. Moving furniture during room shifting is not allowed. Any concerns regarding room changes or requirements should be reported to the warden, and due procedures will be followed.
- 9.3. Rooms must be taken possession of within 10 days of allotment; failure to do so will render the allotment null and void.
- 9.4. Students are responsible for the care and maintenance of fittings and fixtures in their rooms. Alterations of any kind are not allowed without prior written permission from competent authorities.
- 9.5. Problems during shifting must be immediately reported to the warden within the above stipulated time.

10. Penalties and Expulsion

- 10.1. Violations of the above hostel rules may result in last preference during future hostel allotment/fines/suspension, or expulsion from the hostel as per severity.
- 10.2. Persistent offenders will be referred to the Dean and institute Hostel committee for further action.
- 10.3. Students found with prohibited items (alcohol/Marijuana/charas/any prohibited drugs/item/weapon) will face immediate expulsion from the hostel.

Rules for U.G. Hostel – GIRLS

1. General Conduct

- 1.1. All students must respect hostel authorities, staff, and fellow students.
- 1.2. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. Anyone found guilty of ragging or abetting ragging, whether actively or passively, or being a part of conspiracy to promote ragging is liable to be punished in accordance with anti-ragging regulations as well as under the provisions of any penal law for the time being in force and immediate expulsion and banned from the hostel.
- 1.3. Any form of discrimination based on caste, gender, religion, or ethnicity is strictly forbidden.
- 1.4. Smoking, consumption of alcohol, or possession of prohibited substances /items /equipment is strictly banned within hostel premises.
- 1.5. Carrying a valid college ID card is mandatory and must be presented when asked by the hostel authorities.

2. Attendance and Timings

- 2.1. Students must be inside the hostel premises by 11:00 PM. Late entries without prior permission will not be allowed.
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- 2.4. Interns on emergency duty must carry and show their ID card while entering or leaving the hostel during odd hours.

3. Visitors

- 3.1. Visitors are NOT allowed in hostel rooms.
- 3.2. Visitors must sign the visitor's register at the entrance and provide valid ID proof.
